Position Description:

- The Visitor Services Specialist (VSS) will be responsible for
 - Welcoming guests to the museum with an emphasis on ensuring a positive and efficient visitor experience.
 - Ensuring excellent customer service and a positive museum experience that encourages repeat visitation and community participation.
 - Being a brand ambassador for the museum to the surrounding community with knowledge of the museum content.
 - Opening and closing the museum daily
 - Cleaning and organizing the community room
 - The ability to use the POS system (Talech) to check guests into the museum
 - Cash Handling and proper use of the credit card machine
 - Reports run at the end of the day
 - Assisting the Visitor Services and Membership Coordinator with field trip communication to schools
 - Helping visitors become members of the museum onsite and over the phone
 - The VSS will need to be able to enter Membership data quickly and efficiently into the POS system
 - Other duties as assigned
